This can be accomplished through the following activities. Site leadership should determine the actual tasks that the BLS performs from this menu of services.

## Lead Learner

- 1. Model technology integration with <u>TIM framework</u> to support student engagement and mastery.
- 2. Share best practices across site and district.
- 3. Participate in district blended learning specialist training to support site technology integration.
- 4. Contribute as a leader on the **Site Tech Team** with Administrator, Librarian, and Lead Teachers.

## **Facilitate Planning and Implementation**

- 1. Integration of the <u>SAMR</u> model and <u>TIM framework</u> for technology integration.
- 2. Facilitate analysis of site needs for technology integration and assist with planning and implementing PD.
- 3. Support logistics related to site-level technology training events.
- 4. Support PLCs and teachers to effectively integrate technology.
- 5. Assist with the implementation of technology for planning and documenting of weekly PLC meetings.

## **Collaboration and Capacity Building**

- 1. Design, manage, and **share online resources** for teachers including tutorials (Google Drive, Canvas, Microsoft 365).
- 2. Support PLC Leaders to generate and publish technology-based lessons and activities.
- 3. When requested, co-teach lessons demonstrating technology integration.
- 4. Develop protocols for observing effective technology integration in the classroom.
- 5. Organize **classroom visits** for the purpose of improving technology integration.
- 6. **Cover classes** to allow for observations linking technology and learning.

## **Sustainability**

- 1. **Monitor and provide feedback** to teachers regarding technology use and implementation in collaboration with site leadership focusing on needs for professional development, teacher support, student learning, etc.
- 2. **Collect artifacts** that showcase exemplary practices of technology integration that reflect Effective Initial Instruction.
